Manager

Aims: Assisting visitors to the Living Heritage Centre, in the Exhibition, the Chapel and at other fixed points around the building. To put the Exhibition into context and add extra colour to the story of The Bar Convent.

Duties may include:

- Materials provided for learning about the story told by the Exhibition, the background to the BC, Mary Ward and Margaret Clitherow
- Ongoing training and tutoring on new developments

Hours:

- Guides can operate over a full day or a half-day (agreed in advance)
- The number of days a week is down to personal preference

Role Boundaries:

- To follow instructions of ADEM
- No food consumption in working area. Drinks are allowed.
- Not to act as spokesperson for Bar Convent at any time
